Curriculum Vitae:

Dr. Roberto Justus received his MSD in Orthodontics from the University of Washington in 1968. He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Orthodontics (ABO), Professor of undergraduate orthodontics in Technologic University of Mexico since 1973, Professor and Director of Research of the Graduate Department of Orthodontics in Intercontinental University since 1990, Member of the Executive Committee of the World Federation of Orthodontists WFO since 2000, Associate Editor of the WFO Gazette since 2001 and Examiner/Consultant of the Phase III Exam of the ABO since 2002. He was President of the College of Diplomates of the ABO 2003-2004, President of the Foundation of the College of Diplomates of the ABO 2004-2005. He will be WFO President-elect 2010-2015. Dr. Justus has been in private practice, limited to orthodontics, since 1968. He has published twenty scientific papers in orthodontic and research journals, chapters in 3 orthodontic textbooks, 2 guest audio presentations for Practical Reviews in Orthodontics (Oakstone Medical Publishing), and 2 CD-ROM lectures for AAO's Distance Learning Education Program.

He was Visiting Professor in Osaka University, Japan 1991-1992, Visiting and Clinical Associate Professor in the University of British Columbia, Canada 1996-1997 and Dean of College of Dentistry in Kyungpook National University, Korea 2001-2003.
